This Excel file contains up-to-date contact and descriptive data on our WA legislators as an advocacy resource. The file helps to determine district jurisdictions, to generate a variety of mailing lists and labels, to aid research data, and more. The file shares a bulk of education-related advocacy info within a single digital source.

File Features

- **Origin:** Developed originally for WSPTA's Focus Day '08, this file reflects updates to all legislature records as of March 20th, 2008 in preparation for November elections.
- **Main Content:** The file's main spreadsheet, titled "**Hse&Sen All Data**", includes every legislator's contact data and website, plus their assistant's name, office location, term expiration, leadership positions, and committees on which they serve. Also, each is cross-referenced to School Districts, WSPTA Regions and Counties.
- **More Content:** There are ten (10) worksheets within the file (the tabs across the screen bottom). The main worksheet cross-references the core data from 3 of the worksheets on committees & caucuses. The other six (6) worksheets are:
 - **WA Government Web Links:** WA state departments, services, & resources relevant to education, schools and children
 - **Advocacy for Education & Children Web Links:** organizations & resources
 - **Governor's Government Offices:** contact and Cabinet data
 - **House & Senate Home District Offices:** contact info
 - **House & Senate Administration:** offices and contact info
 - **WA School Districts & PTA Regions Cross-Reference to Legislative Districts:** WSPTA-relevant organizational data
- **Updates:** This file will be periodically replaced with an update. Please report errors or outdated data, and please share the creative uses or improvements you develop.
- **Accuracy:** Efforts were made to insure accuracy, but please verify important data to you before employing it. No warranties are made or implied.
- **Size:** The file is about 800 KB – a bulk of data in one source.
